10 Years Strong A Decade of Dedication at Eagle Crest South



In 2015, Eagle Crest South opened its doors with a vision: to create a warm, welcoming senior living community in the heart of La Crosse that could provide exceptional care and a vibrant lifestyle-all in one place. Our original four-story building offered 144 apartments, featuring Independent Living Plus, High Acuity Assisted Living, and Memory Care options. Designed with both comfort and convenience in mind, the community overlooks scenic Swift Creek and the Mississippi River, and is located just behind Emplify Health (Gundersen Medical Center)—placing healthcare, restaurants, shopping, and essential services just minutes away.

By 2020, the demand for high-quality care in our region had grown—and so had we. Eagle Crest South expanded with the addition of a second building, welcoming 181 new apartments and introducing Senior Living as a new option alongside expanded Assisted Living and Memory care services. This growth provided even more opportunities for residents to receive personalized support while enjoying beautifully designed spaces to gather, relax, and thrive.



A Look Back at the Grand Opening of Eagle Crest South!

June 2015 - We're granted our Occupancy License and opened 80 Independent Living Apartments.

July 2015 - Our first Memory Care I opened with 18 apartments. A new option, High Acuity Assisted Living opened 34 apartments.

May 2016 - Due to growing need, our Memory Care II unit welcomed 12 new residents.

January 2020 - Eagle Crest South expanded to offer 180 new Senior Living, Assisted Living, and Memory Care apartments.

Today, **Eagle Crest South is home to over 300 residents across two buildings, each offering a full continuum of care and a wide range of amenities**—from cozy lounges and on-site salons to chef-prepared meals and engaging activities every day of the week. Residents enjoy the freedom to live on their own terms, with the peace of mind that personalized care and support are always nearby.


