One year ago, we celebrated the groundbreaking for our Eagle Crest North expansion in Onalaska. This expansion includes 87 new independent luxury apartments with many new amenities, including: a virtual reality gaming room with Full-Swing golf and gaming simulator. We continue to enhance our amenities to allow for a wonderful living experience. We have also added 18 exterior garages for those who may want a garage to park their vehicle allowing for extra storage space, instead of underground parking.



Eagle Crest North expansion is now 2/3 complete and will open in early January. This project is right on schedule and still running under budget. Exterior work is nearing completion and final grading will begin the end of October. Inside, there are many trades working on finishes. They start from the top floor and work down with over 100 people on site working every day. Apartments on the top 5th floor have most of the appliances and finishes already installed. It's exciting to see a finished look in some of the apartments.

Once again, we completed our annual strategic planning in August. One of our primary goals for this year is to finalize our plan to remodel Riverside Transitional Care, our skilled nursing facility.

Riverside was built in 1983 and has served the community well over the years, but it's time to do some major updating of all the interior finishes and amenities. Another primary focus will be private rooms and functional utility to allow for staffing efficiency. We are looking at different options to increase the number of private rooms we have available. Privacy and independent dignity for the people we serve is a high priority.

I look forward to sharing more details regarding all the exciting developments going on at Eagle Crest Communities.

It is my honor to be in a position to provide healthcare, housing and services to meet the needs and desires of the community. We are here to serve as an extension of your family when you have a need. May every room we open welcome peace.


